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DEFINITIONS:

The following terms have the meanings respectively prescribed for them except as content otherwise demands: (A) "Program" means the aggregate of individual programs or hours that qualify a person to take the State licensing examination; (B) "Course" means a separate component of study contained within the program for which a Student earns hours; (C) "Semester" means a portion of the total program measured in hours and a set period of time; (D) "Academic Year" means a year as measured in clock hours and calendar weeks; (E) "Full-time" means a schedule of no less than thirty-seven and one half hours per week, and "Half-Time" also called part-time, means a schedule of no less than twenty-seven and one half hours per week; (F) "Educational Services" shall include all those services available at and provided by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering as part of the educational process; and (G) "Required Contract End Date" is defined as the last date Student can attend before paying the excessive absence charge of \$10 per hour for any training after Student's "Required Contract End Date" has been reached. It is the maximum timeframe the student is given to complete all program requirements. (Veteran Affairs Students are exempt from all excessive absence charges).

ARTICLE I: OBLIGATIONS OF X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering

Section 1-1 General Obligations of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering: X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering agrees to provide educational services from the Contract Start Date to the Required Contract End Date, in accordance with the provisions of this Contract to undersigned Student.

Section 1-2 Term of Obligation: Educational Services shall be provided to Student pursuant to this Contract for the contracted period of time.

Section 1-3 Facility, Equipment & Educational Staff: Student shall be trained at a facility operated by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering that is licensed by the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering expressly reserves the right to relocate its campus as necessary, and within its full and absolute discretion. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall provide to Student: (1) a Student kit that will include all of the following and shall be used to perform the required practical and client services; supplies in measured quantities for classroom/phase I, and supplies for client services/phase I. Said Student kit is required to be purchased from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering, by all Students, in all programs. Equipment issued in the Student kit is determined at enrollment per the chosen starting date and program. Additions made to the educational services offered and/or the Student kit after Student starts class will not apply to Students unless Student's program cost is adjusted to reflect the change. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall provide instructors who are approved and/or licensed by the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board. Instructor(s) or any other employee(s) of may change from time to time at the sole discretion of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering and without notice to the Student.

Section 1-4 Educational Services: During the contracted enrollment period, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall provide educational services which are designed to prepare Student for the State Board licensing examination. Said educational services are established by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering and may change in accordance with State Board regulation changes. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will do its best to notify Student of such changes.

Section 1-5 Required Contract End Date and Career Assistance: Once Student satisfies his/her contractual obligations as set forth in this contract, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall release certification records and issue a certification that will be submitted to the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board. Although X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering does not guarantee job placement, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall provide postings of relevant jobs as they occur, shall use reasonable efforts to keep in good relations with the local employers, shall invite prospective employers to do on-site presentations and/or interviews, and shall provide reasonable opportunities for Student to visit prospective employers and secure interviews.

ARTICLE II: OBLIGATIONS OF STUDENT

Section 2-1: Student Attendance: Student is purchasing from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering the stated educational services from the Contract Start Date to the Required Contract End Date, so Student is purchasing both training and allotted time from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering, and Student agrees that the term of obligation affords Student with ample time to complete the prescribed program hours. As such, is reserving a seat in class for Student over the contracted period of time, so Student understands that if Student is out of attendance (except during an approved leave of absence) that Student is classified as enrolled, and Student is accruing instructional charges accordingly. Student is required to and agrees to attend classes per the required program schedule, which at the sole and absolute discretion of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering may change from time to time with a thirty-day advance notice to Student. If Student needs to change his/her schedule, Student must do so in writing with consent from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering prior to the change. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering reserves the right to deny any requested schedule changes and to enforce the required program schedule. Student shall receive off all holidays and any other regular school closings (ie: bad weather, teacher in service days, etc.) as defined by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering. A schedule of said holidays can be found in the Student Catalog, but X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering may change them from time to time as deemed necessary.

Section 2-2: Academic Environment: The academic environment of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering simulates an apprenticeship where Student is required to attend regularly and practice prescribed techniques on the general public under the supervision of licensed professionals. Student cannot, and shall not, be compensated for any services rendered while being a Student at X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering, but Student can receive tips. Student acknowledges that in order to receive the education provided, Student shall be treated as an apprentice as it pertains to attendance, conduct, teamwork and customer service. Student is expected to take all client services prescribed, offer each client excellent customer service and to participate in all aspects of the customer experience, including, but not limited to, pre-booking, gaining referrals, generating clients, client retention, selling retail, and up-selling. Offering poor customer service, and/or refusing a client, a service or to participate in any aspect of the customer experience are grounds for progressive discipline up to and including expulsion. Student acknowledges that clients represent an educational component for all Students, and Student can, and is encouraged to, establish a clientele while at X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering that Student can take into his/her career. As such, in order to maintain educational integrity, unprofessional conduct is strictly prohibited and any such conduct and/or other actions, such as speaking poorly about anything pertaining to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering and/or its guests in front of clients is grounds for progressive discipline up to and including expulsion.

Section 2-3: Required Contract End Date (Maximum Timeframe): The estimated Contract End Date is based on Student attending the required schedule. The Required Contract End Date is based upon the X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering attendance rate requirement of 90%, per this contract and represents the end of this contracted period of enrollment and maximum timeframe for the Student to complete the program requirements and graduate.

Section 2-4: Satisfactory Academic Progress: Student agrees to comply with X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy as prescribed in the Student Catalog.

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Section 2-5: VA Students: VA Students are required to follow the same SAP policy as non-VA Students, as well as additional requirements (see Student Catalog).

Section 2-6: Absenteeism: Per the X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering attendance policy, Student cannot miss on average in one month more than twenty-two and one half (22.2) hours if Student is on a full-time schedule or ten and one half (10.5) hours if Student is on a part-time schedule, in order to maintain the required 90% attendance rate. For any absence and/or anytime Student comes in late or leaves early, the time missed shall be deducted from the allotted hours. If Student is not in attendance for fourteen (14) consecutive calendar days and not on an approved leave of absence, Student may be withdrawn. Students are expected to arrive either on time or early every day and shall not be admitted to class late unless Student presents the necessary documentation, such as a doctor's note, written documentation, and management approval. Likewise, if Student's schedule provides for a break(s), Student must abide by the allotted break time(s) and will not be admitted back to class late. See the Student Handbook & Catalog for further details.

Section 2-7: Leave of Absence (LOA): A LOA is defined as a temporary interruption in Student's program of study where Student is not in attendance during the LOA. LOAs are for emergency situations, such as medical, legal and or military conditions, deaths in the immediate family, natural disasters or mitigating circumstances beyond the control of the student. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering reserves the sole and absolute right to deny any LOAs. Both X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering and Student agree to abide by the LOA policy in the Student Catalog.

Section 2-8: Re-Enrollment: If Student is withdrawn, they must apply for re-enrollment. Refer to the Student Catalog for further details.

Section 2-9: Transfers From Other Barber Schools: For Students transferring into X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering from another barber school, if Student is not able to satisfy all Graduation Requirements by the required date of graduation per this Contract, Student will be withdrawn. In the event X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering does not accept all previous hours accumulated by Student at Student's previous school. Student understands that the difference between the hours previously accumulated and the hours accepted by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering are permanently lost per Ohio law for credit at X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering.

Section 2-10: Completion of Program: In order to fulfill the obligations of this contract, to receive the certification from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering and to be eligible to take the State Board licensing examination, Student must: (1) have a minimum cumulative grade point average of seventy-six percent (76%) or higher; (2) have all financial obligations to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering satisfied prior to Required Contract End Date or made satisfactory payment arrangements; and (3) have completed all required program hours. X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering reserves the right at its sole and absolute discretion to change, from time to time, the requirements of graduation with a reasonable notice to Student. Upon graduation, Student will receive a diploma from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering identifying the program Student graduated from and the year Student graduated.

Section 2-11: Release of Hours: Upon graduation, Student must have a barber instructor and or the school director signature certifying that Student has completed the program and is eligible to take the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board licensing examination before X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will release Student's hours. If Student is transferring to another barber school, Student must have all financial obligations met per this Contract or have made satisfactory payment arrangements before X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will release Student's hours.

Section 2-12: Compliance with Rules: Student agrees to review and abide by the Student Uniform Dress Code, the Student Catalog, and all other rules and regulations, all of which may be modified from time-to-time by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering at its sole and absolute discretion where Student agrees to abide by all changes. Student agrees to abide by all rules posted and implied. Student understands that customers of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering represent educational components for all Students, so if Student causes in any way a customer of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering to leave, Student has damaged the other Students' education (ie: Student speaks poorly of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering which causes a client not to return to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering for future services; this has hurt other Students' education). To protect the education of other Students, Student agrees to not participate in any gossip and/or speaking poorly about X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering its owners, employees, Students, clients, guests, facilities, equipment and all other aspects related to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering in front of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering's customers (Students and clients). Student agrees to only complain in a private setting with a qualified X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering official and to keep the contents of the complaint private. Student acknowledges that it is necessary for X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering to maintain and enforce said rules and regulations in order to provide a proper educational environment for all Students. Failure to comply with X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering's rules and/or regulations may result in suspension or expulsion of Student depending upon the severity of the offense. Grounds for withdraw include theft, vandalism, substance abuse, threats or acts of violence, discrimination, poor attendance per this Contract, repeat violations of lesser offenses, slander or other malicious behavior, and other offenses deemed by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering at its sole and absolute discretion. Refer to the Student Catalog.

Section 2-13: Damage & Theft: Student is responsible to replace at Student's cost any issued equipment that is lost, stolen, damaged or used by Student prematurely and/or inappropriately. Student shall use furniture and equipment owned by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering, and Student acknowledges that Student is responsible for said furniture and equipment while using it and thus agrees to promptly reimburse X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering for costs and expenses associated with the repair and/or replacement of any furniture and/or equipment damaged by Student. Student shall not remove any property of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering or its guests from the premises of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering. As a portion of required training, Student shall perform all assign duties. Student understands that personally using any supplies without paying for them is theft (ie: not paying for hair color and using it on him/herself). Student shall be liable for any forms of theft by Student to any property of or its landlord or guests. Student shall further be liable for any and all attorney's fees and/or court and/or collection and/or repair costs accrued by or its landlord or its guests in connection with the repair or replacement or the cost of obtaining any legal remedy in regard to property of or its landlord or its guests which has been damaged and/or wrongfully removed by Student. Student acknowledges that Student is responsible for aforesaid costs and expenses and agrees to promptly reimburse and indemnify X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering for the loss or damage of any of X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering's property while in the custody, possession or control of Student.

Section 2-14: Student Information: Student shall promptly notify X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering in writing of any personal changes of physical address, email address, home phone number, work phone number, cell phone number, and places of employment. Said notice must be received within fourteen (14) days of the date the change(s) occurred. If Student does not notify X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering in accordance with this section, Student shall be liable for any and all additional expenses incurred by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering as a result of said failure.

Section 2-15 Previous Education and Training:

- (A) Student, currently or previously enrolled in a school licensed by the board who intends to transfer to another licensed school shall complete a transfer request form.
- (B) The school shall file a certified training record and board approved "discontinuance form" with the board within fourteen days of receiving the student's notice of transfer.
- (C) Upon receipt of the certified training record and discontinuance form, the board shall notify the school to which the student wishes to transfer of the number of clock hours approved.

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- (D) If the student has not completed the student's contractual obligations to pay fees, tuition, etc. the board may not transfer those hours until the contract is in good standing. The school shall notify the board that a student's contractual obligations have been met upon completion by the student.
- (E) If the original school refuses for reasons other than contractual financial obligations to release a student's certified training record and discontinuance form, the board, or its authorized agent, may request the records from the school in order to establish the hours earned for the student. If the board requests the record, the school shall promptly provide the students complete training record to the board.
- (F) Any student wishing to transfer schools shall not accrue any clock hours for training at the new school until the new school has received an official transfer of hours letter from the board. This provision does not apply to students enrolled in a career technical school that seek to transfer to another career technical school in this state.
- (G) An exception to this rule will be made if two schools are owned by the same person. When a student transfers schools and the schools share ownership, a school shall not be required to file a discontinuance form but shall submit an electronic form as specified by the board. If the student does not immediately transfer, but instead waits six months or more, the school shall use the discontinuance form and shall file that form with the board.
- (H) A student who desires to transfer to another school shall only receive those clock or credit hours from the current program of study that directly apply to the new program of study.
 - (1) Not all hours within a designated program of study shall be transferable to another program of study.
 - (2) Of the clock hours that the board finds may transfer to the new school, the new school shall determine the number of clock hours it is willing to accept. The school shall notify the student prior to the student signing the contract with the new school.
 - (3) Upon entering the new school, the student will take an assessment according to the barbering curriculum set forth by the Ohio State Cosmetology and Barber Board. The results of the assessment will determine the number of hours that will be accepted.

ARTICLE III: WITHDRAWAL AND SETTLEMENT POLICY

Section 3-1: Enrollment Termination: If X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering classifies Student as unofficially withdrawn after Student is absent for a period of fourteen (14) consecutive days, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will classify Student's official termination date as Student's last day of physical attendance, which shall be used for computing Student's financial liability. Unofficial withdrawals for clock hour are determined by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering through monitoring clock hour attendance. The refund is calculated based on scheduled hours from Student's start date through Student's last date of attendance. Student shall be responsible for a \$250.00 Termination Fee in any termination under this article. If Student and/or Student's legal guardian (in the event Student is a dependent minor) terminates his/her enrollment at X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering or X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering terminates Student's enrollment, such termination must be done so in writing. Said notice shall be served personally upon the opposite party or by U.S. Mail, postage pre-paid. If Student delivers notice in person, it must be delivered exclusively to a school Manager/Director. Notice shall be effective according to the postmark on said notice or upon the date of personal delivery. Any refunds due to Student by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering under this article shall be made to Student within forty-five (45) days of a determination that Student has withdrawn, whether officially or unofficially, which shall occur on the earlier of the dates that:

- (1) Student is not accepted by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering and is entitled to a refund of all monies paid except the \$1,000.00 non-refundable Application Fee which can be applied for up to one year from the original start date deposited for, (may be refundable by senior management approval for military circumstances, and circumstances as determined by the Financial Planning Department.);
- (2) Student or legal guardian cancels this Contract and demands his/her money back in writing within three business days of signing this Contract regardless of whether Student has actually started training, all monies collected by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering are refunded except the \$1,000.00 non-refundable Application Fee (may be refundable by senior management approval);
- (3) Student or legal guardian cancels this Contract after three business days of signing this Contract but prior to entering classes, Student is entitled to a refund of all monies paid to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering less the \$1,000.00 non-refundable Application Fee (may be refundable by senior management approval) and the \$150.00 Registration Fee;
- (4) Student or legal guardian notifies X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering of Student's withdrawal;
- (5) If Student is on an approved LOA and Student does not return by the final specified date of return, and/or Student notifies X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering in writing of Student's intent to terminate, Student shall be terminated and the date of withdrawal shall be the earlier of the date of expiration of the LOA or the official date of the notification; or
- (6) Student is withdrawn by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering. If Student or their legal guardian cancels Student's Contract or Student is discontinued by X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering after three business days of the signing of this Contract and after Student has started classes, Student shall be liable for the per item charge of all materials issued to Student by that time (Student keeps issued materials(non-refundable)), for the \$1,000.00 Application Fee, the 150.00 Registration Fee, the \$250.00 Termination Fee and for tuition according to the Tuition Adjustment Schedule:

Student understands that if Student is out of attendance (except during an approved LOA) that Student is classified as enrolled, and Student is accruing instructional charges accordingly. Equipment charges and fees are always held separate from tuition charges. If Student is forced into termination for reasons beyond the immediate control of Student, such as dismemberment, natural disasters, etc., X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will make a settlement to Student

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which is reasonable and fair to both parties. All monies owed to the Federal Department of Education (USDOE) Title IV Programs, as calculated per current Refund/Return to Title IV Policies as published by the USDOE, shall be returned to the appropriate USDOE Title IV Programs within forty-five (45) days of determining Student's withdrawal; not to exceed sixty (60) days for unofficial withdrawals.

Section 3-2: Program Cancellation & School Closure:

1. If a course and/or program is canceled subsequent to Student's enrollment and before instruction in the course and/or program has begun, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering at its option shall: (a) provide a full refund of all monies paid; or (b) provide completion of the course and/or program.
2. If X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering cancels a course and/or program and ceases to offer instruction after Student has enrolled and instruction has begun, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall at its option: (a) provide a pro-rata refund for all students transferring to another school based on the hours accepted by the receiving school; or (b) provide completion of the course and/or program; or (c) participate in a Teach-Out Agreement; or (d) provide a full refund of all monies paid.
3. If X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering closes permanently and ceases to offer instruction after Student has enrolled and instruction has begun, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will make arrangements for students where at its option shall: (a) provide a pro-rata refund; or (b) participate in a Teach-Out Agreement.
4. In the event of a pro-rata refund, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering shall use a pro-rata calculation to determine Student's tuition obligation versus the percentages reflected in the tuition adjustment schedule, and a list of all the students who were enrolled at the time of school closure including the amount of each pro-rata refund will be reported to NACCAS.

ARTICLE IV: TUITION AND PAYMENT

Section 4-1: Standard Tuition: Student promises to pay X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering the "total program cost" as specified on page two of this Contract, representing charges for tuition, fees, books, kit and supplies for the stated program and for the enrollment time period (refer to the Promissory Note). If Student fails to meet his/her financial obligations as set forth in this Enrollment Contract, Promissory Note and/or other written, approved payment plan(s) between Student and, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering, Student will be withdrawn from X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering via written notice; and Student's accumulated hours/credits will not be transferable until such time that the unsatisfied financial obligations are met. If Student is utilizing Title IV Federal Financial Aid to pay X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering for Student's enrollment and Student loses this assistance, Student promises to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering pay any balance owed to X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering by Student for said loss.

Section 4-2: Dishonored Checks: Student shall pay the sum of twenty dollars (\$50.00) and any additional fees as may be assessed by a financial institution or other lender for any and all checks or other instruments which are dishonored for any reason. Section 4-4: Payments & Fees: X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering recognizes that for the good of the student's education and career goals, a change in program or campus may be an option. In such cases, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering will review and evaluate the benefits of such changes and determine if it is acceptable. If approved, fees associated with such changes, include a Change of Program Fee of \$50, and/or a Campus Transfer Fee of \$50. For payment of fees and tuition, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering accepts cash, check, money orders, and major credit cards. Fee Policy (waiver): Students who have mitigating circumstances, X-Quisite Cutz School of Barbering may, at its discretion, opt to waive certain fees.

If any portion or provision hereof is contrary to the provisions of Ohio Law, the remaining portion(s) shall be binding upon the parties. Any disputes regarding this Contract shall be settled in the Butler County Courts of Common Pleas. Oral modifications of this Contract are not binding. This Contract may be altered only by a written agreement signed by the party whom enforcement of any waiver, change, modification, extension, or discharge is sought. Recovery hereunder by Student shall not exceed amounts paid by Student hereunder. Student shall not assign or otherwise transfer any rights or obligations that Student has acquired pursuant to this Contract to any other party at any time.
